- LB 624. 9 May 1907. Lothian to Lawson. Glad his spree is over. Will send proofs.
Encl. receipt 29th April 1907. Henry Lawson acknowledges receipt of 15
from the 50 due for the 2 volumes
- LB 625. 15 May 1907. A.B. Davies to Lothian. Asking for Agreement and for information
on the money already paid and to be paid to Lawson.
Note: Davies was solicitor -- and mediator -- for both Lawson and his wife
- LB 626. 17 May 1907. Lothian to Davies. Sending copy of Agreement. With copy of
receipt from Lawson for 15
- LB 627 (a) 17 May 1907. Lothian to Lawson. Sending agreement. Dissatisfied with Lawson's
dealings with Fitchett (of the Review of Reviews). Sending proofs
(b) 21 May 1907. Lothian to Lawson. Kalgoorlie Sun cannot trace Lawson's "diogenes"
- LB 628. 20 May 1907. Lawson to Lothian. Will come to Melbourne "to fix things up"
- LB 629. 4 June 1907. Lawson to Lothian. Send promissory note to Robertson made out to
A & R for 35 for rest of book. Will see proofs through and will "come over
if necessary"
- LB 630. 5 June 1907. Lothian to Lawson. Sending promissory note for 35 payable 4 months
to A & R. Do not come over
- LB 631. (a) 23 Sept 1907. Lawson to Lothian. Lone Hand cannot publish "Editor of the
Comet" until November
(b) No date, but mid-1907(?). Lothian to Lawson. Wants to publish book of
stories in October. Annotated by Frank Fox: "I can't publish Comet until
November"
- LB 632. 24 Sept 1907. Lothian to Lawson. Asking for proofs so as to publish 5 November.
Annotated by Frank Fox: Impossible publish "Comet" now but has "Stranger's
Friend" in type
- LB 633. 1 Oct. 1907. Lawson to Lothian. Sending "Mateship" next page and "The
Stranger's Friend" to replace "Editor of the Comet". (Lothian did not return
Comet")
- LB 634. 5 Dec. 1907. Lothian to Lawson. Expressing dissatisfaction with his dilatoriness
and failure to deliver
- LB 635. 6 July 1910. Lawson to Lothian. (a) Covering letter for (b).
(b) Use "Mateship" and "The Stranger's Friend". Has lost proofs of Triangles
of Life. With typed lists of Contents of the verse (For Australia) and the
prose (Triangles of Life)
